The Potentially Avoidable Events (PAEs) serve as markers for quality of care concerns. Do they accurately represent the quality of patient care you deliver? In this webinar, you will learn essential information about:

- Specifications for calculation of each PAE (which OASIS items contribute)
- Importance of accurate OASIS responses (errors in data collection may trigger PAE despite excellent care delivery)
- How PAEs affect your State Survey
