

## Risk Management in an Uncertain World Documentation & ICD-10 Updates for Clinical Staff

### Webinar 1: The Basics—March 8, 2016

- Introduce clinicians to the nuts and bolts of clinical documentation that support ICD-10 and its application to diverse categories in the top 50 diagnoses for home care providers.
- Explore common and complex home care scenarios with a focus on diabetes, aftercare for surgery, and behavioral health signs, symptoms and diagnoses.
- Review the clinical documentation necessary for these diagnoses.

### Webinar 3: Rehab Diagnoses—April 5, 2016

- This webinar is a must-view for your rehabilitation team.
- Focus on introductory concepts by delving deeper into the top 50 - specifically the most prevalent home health rehabilitative diagnoses.
- Examine common and complex scenarios for acute fractures, injuries, sequela of cerebrovascular accidents and other top neuromuscular diagnoses.

### Webinar 2: Cardiac & Pulmonary Diagnoses—March 22, 2016

- Build upon the introductory concepts and use scenarios to address more of the top 50 home care diagnoses.
- Detail the critical elements and substantiating medical documentation specific to cardiac and pulmonary diagnoses.

### Webinar 4: Wounds—April 19, 2016

- Enhance staff's understanding of the required documentation for the ICD-10 expanded wound diagnoses.
- Address more of the top 50 home health diagnoses.
- Detail the clinical logic and documentation necessary for diabetic ulcers, pressure ulcers, and other diverse wounds.
