- Submit your proposal by e-mail and include a description of the content of the session in approximately 200 words.
- **Provide a title** for your submission. We encourage titles that reflect the conference theme: "Superheroes of Home Care"
- Indicate the target audience for your presentation.
- Identify level of learner the material is intended for intermediate, advanced, etc.
- List the duration of the presentation: <u>90</u> minutes is preferred.
- Provide your name and contact information: address, phone, email, and any other information we need to be able to reach you. Also include your current employer and your title.
- If you will have a co-presenter, we need to know their name and contact information.

Requirements for Accepted Presentations!

You will be notified of the status of your proposal - accepted or not accepted.

If your presentation is accepted you will be asked to:

- Meet deadlines for additional material needed. Deadlines will be stated in the acceptance email along with the documents and information needed for the conference brochure.
- Submit all documentation needed to achieve continuing education standards.
- Prepare handouts in advance of conference for posting.
- Submit other support documentation timely.
